Snap A Selfie At Callaway Memorial Tower

The Callaway Monument was built in 1929 as a tribute to textile magnate Fuller E. Callaway. It is located in the historic Hillside neighborhood, which was once a thriving mill village. Nearby is Beacon Brewing Co. named after 'The Beacon,' a newsletter that was published for mill employees each month. Inside the brewery, you'll find murals modeled after these newsletters. Explore The City Center And LaFayette Square

In the heart of downtown, you'll find a statue of Marquis de LaFayette in the center of a circular fountain. The statue is an exact copy of the original by Ernest-Eugene Hiolle that stands in Le Puy, Auvergne, France. It was cast by American sculptor Harry Jackson in Camaiore, Italy, in 1974 and is the property of LaGrange College, on permanent loan to the city of LaGrange.
